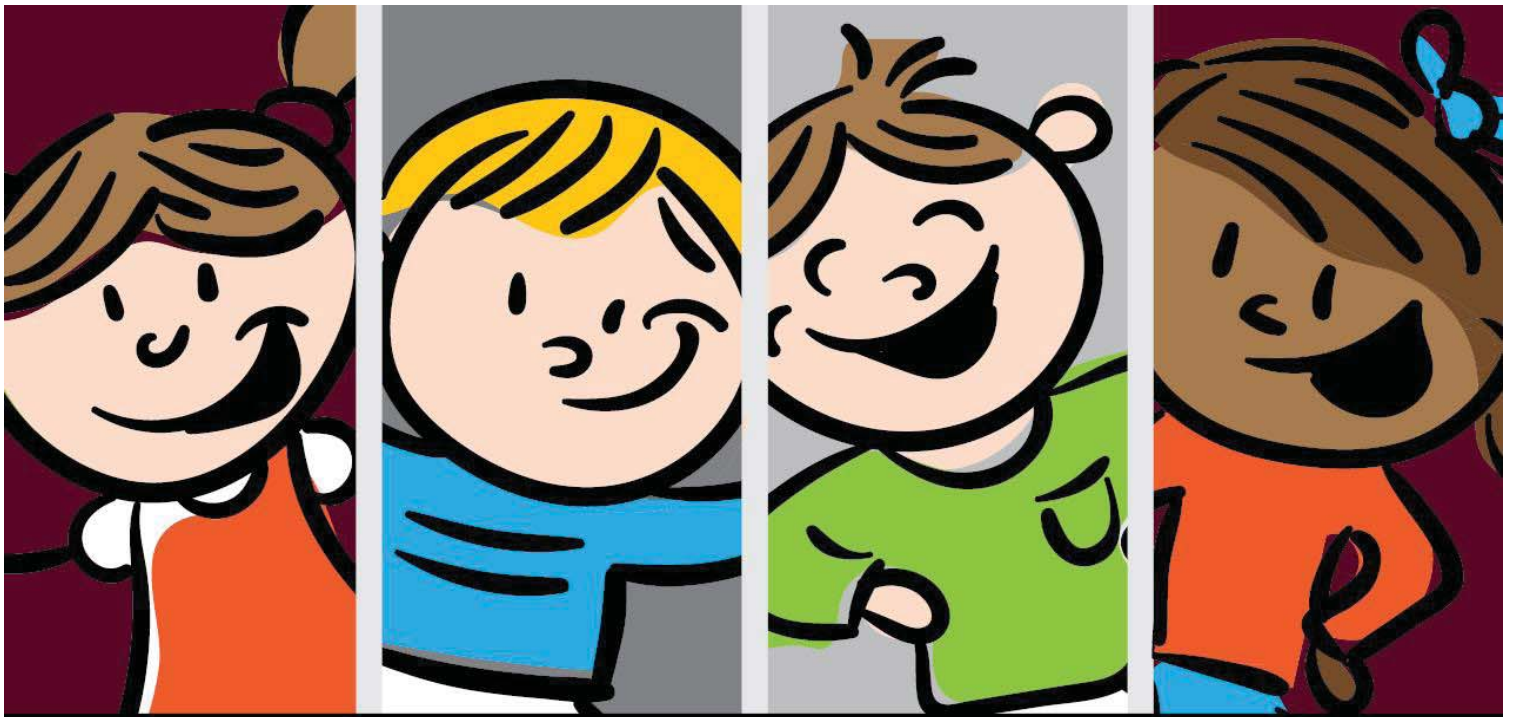
We are so excited to celebrate your child's successful year in person.


